Application Process for Incoming Freshmen

The Camelback Montessori College Preparatory (CMCP) application process has been designed to ensure that potential students and parents understand our program and are committed to academics. Completed applications will be reviewed and considered for admission to CMCP. Admissions are not considered on a rolling basis for the priority application. Instead, three application cycles exist, priority, secondary, and rolling admissions. In the priority application process, there will be up to 48 available spots for students and notification of acceptances will occur sooner than the secondary process. Admissions are based on a scored rubric. If there are more qualified applicants than spaces available, a lottery for qualified applicants will take place, with priority given in the following order: students living within the Phoenix Union High School boundaries, students with a sibling currently attending Camelback High School, students with a parent working in Phoenix Union High School District. A waitlist will be maintained for qualified applicants in the event that openings in enrollment occur. In the secondary application process, there is neither guarantee of admissions nor a guarantee of being placed on the waitlist as there may be no availability by the secondary deadline. Rolling admissions occurs after the secondary timeline; interviews are scheduled and granted periodically as determined by the volume of applicants and timing in the school year.

PRIORITY APPLICATIONS ARE DUE

Ensure the application is clearly marked with "MONTESSORI APPLICATION." Please ensure all materials on the checklist, including letters of recommendation, transcripts and essa, are present. You may hand-deliver the application to Camelback High School, mail to 4612 North 28th Street, Phoenix, AZ 85016, email a PDF/JPG to camelbackmontessori@gmail.com or submit the online application by **no later than 3:00 pm on Friday, January 19, 2024.** Incomplete application packets cannot be accepted or reviewed.

We recommend all applicants to submit paperwork to register for Camelback High School when applying, as this will enroll students more quickly if admitted and have higher priority for competitive electives. See www.pxu.org/enroll for registration links or you may also pick up a registration packet from the main office.

January 31, 2024 Finalists notified

By this date, finalists will be notified through email. Please ensure you have provided an accurate e-mail address in your application.

February 7, 2024 Finalists attend admissions interview

Each finalist must attend the admissions at Camelback High School. At this time, finalists will be given an opportunity to get to know one another through group activities and participate in interviews with the CMCP selection committee.

February 23, 2024 Notification of acceptance

Accepted applicants must be sure to pick up a registration packet from Camelback High School or register online to Camelback High School at www.pxu.org/enroll to complete the admissions process. If you need another copy, please see the Camelback Registration Office for your registration packet.

Applications received AFTER Friday, January 19, 2024

If seats are available after the January 19th, 2024 confirmation date, Camelback Montessori will reach out to applicants shortly after receiving all required materials to schedule interviews. Application Process for Incoming Freshmen & Sophomores after the Secondary Deadline

Internal Camelback High School Applicants:

If spots are available in our freshmen and/or sophomore class(es), <u>current students already enrolled at</u>

<u>Camelback High School</u> have priority over all vacancies provided they meet admissions requirements.

Qualified students at Camelback High School may possibly be accepted for transfer into the Montessori program during the next closest quarter or semester. These students must show a strong academic record as indicated on the rubric, meet with the Micro-School Leader, complete the application and interview with the teachers. Please see your counselor for more information or reach out to Danchi Nguyen on Teams.

Applicants outside of Camelback High School:

If and only if vacancies exist <u>after</u> placing Camelback High School students, outside transfers may be considered. Potential outside candidates will shadow, complete an application, and interview with teachers, which will be scored on a modified rubric. The student must demonstrate a strong academic record as indicated on the rubric.

Junior/Senior Application Statement

Due to the unique nature of our program, intensive college preparation provided during the Freshmen and Sophomore years, and the close-knit community formed between students, we only accept Juniors and Seniors if:

- The Junior/Senior is on track for high school graduation for all required coursework
- The Junior/Senior is on track for In-State University Admissions based on Aptitude and Competency Criteria
- The Junior/Senior completes a full application (to include 2 letters of recommendation, statement of intent, transcripts for all high school years and current progress grades) and interviews

- ➤ **Optional**: 1 letter of recommendation by an adult other than a teacher (ie coach, club sponsor, pastor, volunteer coordinator, employer, etc.), to be mailed directly to Camelback Montessori or submitted electronically.
