Cesar Chavez High School recognizes that each student's mode of dress and appearance is a manifestation of personal style and individual preference. We will not interfere with the right of students and their parents to make decisions regarding their appearance except when their choices affect the educational program of our school or the health and safety of others. To that end, stakeholder groups have created a dress code policy that is gender-neutral, non-discriminatory, and non-judgmental. Simply stated, at Cesar Chavez High School we dress for success.

While on campus all individuals:

1. Shall not wear suggestive printing or pictures on clothing (including headwear) promoting or suggesting themes about sex, alcohol, drugs, violence, or gangs.
2. Shall wear Student ID's at all times. Must be visible.
3. Shall not wear clothing that has been altered to reveal suggestive parts of the body.
4. Shall wear all pants, shorts, or skirts with the waist of the garment at or above the top of the hip.
5. Shall not wear undergarments as outerwear or have undergarments showing.
6. Shall not wear hairnets or other hair coverings, including bandanas, and do-rags except in cases of recognized religious beliefs or for medical reasons.
7. Shall not wear nonprescription sunglasses in the buildings and/or in the classrooms.
8. Shall wear shoes at all times. House shoes are not permitted.

Students dressed inappropriately will be referred to an administrator and given the following opportunities to adhere to our dress for success policy.

- a. Change clothes
- b. Call parents/guardians to bring them an appropriate change of clothes
- c. Purchase clothing from the bookstore.

If parents/guardians cannot be contacted and/or students refuse to change, a referral will be processed for defiance of authority.
