Thank you for your interest in Bioscience High School! We are a very different kind of high school with some unique characteristics. Please read carefully through the school overview and student profile on the previous page of this application to help you determine if we are a good fit for your interests.

At Bioscience, we don't expect you to be perfect, but we do expect you to grow. We teach a "Growth Mindset," which means that we encourage learning over grades. We embrace mistakes as an opportunity to learn. In fact, our grading is based upon your growth and ability to meet essential competencies, not on points and percent.

We offer an all-honors level curriculum with lots of opportunities to earn college credit during your junior and senior year.
