

College Application Checklist

Remember to have the following items with you:

Student Information

- For U.S. Citizens and Permanent Residents:*

*Social security number**

- Personal information:*

Email address, home address, and phone numbers

Use LEGAL NAME

- Dual Enrollment:*

Are you a high school student currently attending or have attended college? Know the dates of attendance (month/year) and coordinating college.

- Grades:*

StudentVue or Transcript (GPA, class rank, ACT scores, courses)

Residency: Determines In-State Tuition

- Date YOU began living in Arizona:*

This may be your date of birth

- Do you have a driver's license, permit or AZ ID?*

If so, bring it. You may be asked to provide additional information.

- Date YOUR PARENT(S) began living in Arizona***

- Know whether your parent(s) filed taxes in AZ in 2021***

**Students without social security numbers are still able to apply using 000-00-0000. If applying to a public institution, it will have an impact on tuition.*

***Students in a legal guardianship/foster care living situation will not need parent information.*
