


How to Access and Use Peterson's Test Prep

- If you are trying to use this resource from home, you will need to enter the appropriate login information. Visit your school library for the login information required for remote access.




Taking practice tests, accessing the eBooks, and using the webinars will require that you register your account. . .

- New User Signup you will need to register in Peterson's Test Prep since it is the only way you can get your test scores and progress every time you take a practice test or use a webinar. Select Register to create account.
- If you have already created an account, select Login and enter your username and password in the Login screen.



- Note: You will need a valid email to register and be able to retrieve or reset your username or password if you forget it. Use your PXU email when registering in Peterson's Test Prep. It will automatically become your username.
- Passwords must be at least 8 characters, including numbers and special characters (!@#\$%). Use a variation of your PXU password when registering so it is easy to remember.
