LearningExpress LIBRARY

From the EBSCO landing page, select the LearningExpress icon.

EBSCO LearningExpress has two separate modules: LearningExpress Library (under the Public Library heading) and PrepSTEP (under the High School heading). Both resources provide academic skill-building, test preparation, and career exploration.

- LearningExpress Library gives students access to test preparation for ACT, ASVAB, PSAT, SAT, AP, CED, and much more. Also, skill-building resources and prep for the U.S. citizenship exam and Green Card in Spanish.
- PrepSTEP is a high school focused resource with skill-building practice and review for computer skills, English language arts, math, science, and social studies. Also included in PrepSTEP are career exploration and college prep resources.

Ferguson's Career Guidance Center is a comprehensive career exploration resource offering information on careers, colleges, scholarships, an interest inventory, and video interviews.

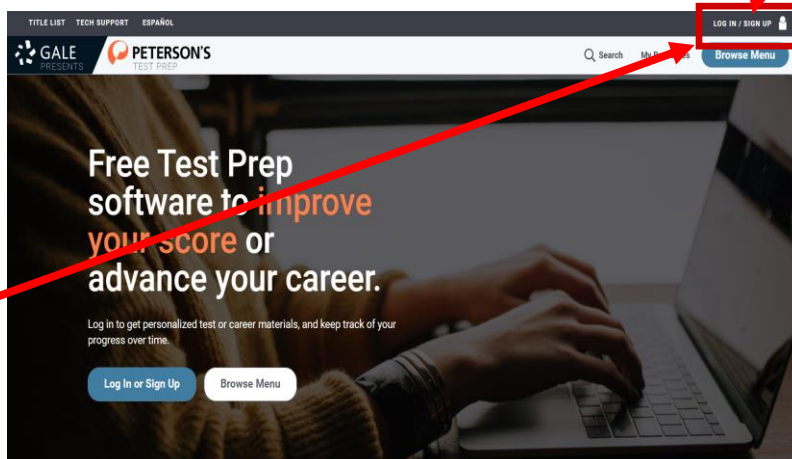

Taking practice tests, accessing the eBooks, and using the webinars will require that you register your account. . .

- **New User Signup** – you will need to register in Peterson’s Test Prep since it is the only way you can get your test scores and progress every time you take a practice test or use a webinar. Select **Register** to create account.
- If you have already created an account, select **Login** and enter your **username** and **password** in the Login screen.



- Note: You will need a valid email to register and be able to retrieve or reset your username or password if you forget it. **Use your PXU email when registering in Peterson’s Test Prep. It will automatically become your username.**
- Passwords must be at least 8 characters, including numbers and special characters (!@#%\$%). **Use a variation of your PXU password when registering so it is easy to remember.**
