The Phoenix Union High School District (PXU) has many choices to offer high school students. Open enrollment enables Arizona students to attend a public school whether or not they live within the school or district boundaries. At Phoenix Union, we welcome students to explore how they can experience high school at one of our 21 high schools or in one of our many Magnet Programs.

The following conditions apply to the Open Enrollment Program:

1. A Student Enrollment Form (T1) must be completed.
2. An Open Enrollment Form must be completed. (on reverse)
3. Acceptance is subject to the capacity limit established for the school, program, and/or its grade level.
4. Student transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/legal guardian with the exception of students attending a Magnet Program or Metro Tech High School. Students that are attending a Magnet Program that is outside of their home attendance zone or Metro Tech High School can request that PXU provide them with available transportation.
5. Providing false information on this form may result in the request being denied or admission revoked.
6. **Specialty schools and programs have additional enrollment applications and requirements that must be completed and approved prior to acceptance.**

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Forms must be completed by the individual requesting enrollment, and must be signed by the parent/legal guardian and student. Consideration for admittance will be determined by the administration of the receiving school.

La inscripción abierta permite a los estudiantes de Arizona el asistir a una escuela pública o ya sea que viva dentro de los límites de la escuela o del distrito. En Phoenix Unión, damos la bienvenida a los estudiantes a que exploren como pueden experimentar la preparatoria en una de nuestras 21 escuelas preparatorias o en uno de nuestros Programas Magnet.

Las siguientes condiciones aplican al Programa de Matriculación Abierta:

1. La Forma de Inscripción del Estudiante (T1) debe ser llenada.
2. La Forma de Inscripción Abierta debe ser llenada. (en el reverso)
3. La aceptación está sujeta al límite de la capacidad establecida para la escuela, programa y/o de su nivel de grado.
4. Transportación estudiantil será la responsabilidad del padre/tutor legal con la excepción de estudiantes que asistan a un Programa Magnet o Metro Tech High School. Los estudiantes que asisten a un Programa Magnet que se encuentre fuera de su zona de asistencia o Metro Tech High School pueden solicitar que PXU le proporcione transportación disponible.
5. El proporcionar información falsa en esta forma puede resultar en que la solicitud sea negada o la admisión sea revocada.
6. **Escuelas Especializadas y programas tienen aplicaciones de inscripciones adicionales y requisitos que deben ser aprobados y llenados antes de ser aceptados.**
