

ACT Breakdown & Quick Tips

What is the ACT?

- ❑ The ACT is a national college admissions examination that consists of subject area tests in: English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing.
- ❑ The ACT includes 215 multiple-choice questions, plus the writing exam. It takes approximately 3 hours and 40 minutes to complete.
- ❑ PXU juniors take the ACT Exam for free each year. Waivers are available for students who need to retake the exam.

Test Format & Structure

The order in which the exam is given each year, which does not change, and how each test is structured.

English Exam - 75 Questions in 45 minutes
(9 minute passage)

Math Exam - 60 Questions in 60 minutes

Reading Exam - 40 Questions in 35 minutes
(8:45 minute passage)

Science Exam - 40 Questions in 35 minutes

Writing Exam - One prompt in 40 minutes

- ❑ Fee waivers are available in counseling to retake the test.
- ❑ Multiple-choice scores are normally available within two weeks after each national test date, but it can sometimes take up to eight weeks. Writing scores are normally available about two weeks after the multiple-choice scores.

- ❑ Fee waivers are available in counseling to retake the test.
- ❑ Most SAT scores are released about two weeks after the test day. June scores take longer, up to six weeks.
