MEMORANDUM FOR Parents/Guardians of JROTC Cadets

SUBJECT: Uniform Wear/Maintenance Responsibilities and In-ranks Inspections

1. The JROTC Uniform is provided to all cadets by the U.S. Government at no cost to cadets. LET 1 cadets who are confirmed for returning to JROTC the second semester will be issued the JROTC uniform during the first semester based on the following conditions:
 - (1) availability of proper size;
 - (2) by direction of Parent/Guardian;
 - (3) by confirmation as a special team member in good standing; and/or
 - (4) by request of the cadet.

2. Wearing the Uniform is a distinct privilege, as it represents the vital core of pride and respect to every Military Service member, past and present. JROTC cadets are expected to wear a JROTC Class "B" Uniform to school one day a week, usually on a Wednesday, to all of his/her classes the entire school day.
 - a. Cadets who have PE, Weight Training, Ceramics or any other class that requires a prescribed uniform are expected to change clothing, or protect the JROTC Uniform from damage.
 - b. Cadets who are absent from Uniform day/In-ranks inspection are required to make-up this requirement upon their first return day to school.

3. The JROTC Uniform is recognized as professional dress and satisfies the school requirement for "professional dress day." Cadets who are not issued a JROTC Uniform are still required to be graded during In-ranks inspections. Scoring criteria is adjusted, however, to preclude unfair grading. Cadets wearing civilian clothing during In-ranks will comply with not only professional dress standards, but also all school dress code criteria.

4. Cadets will be inspected while in uniform for proper fit and wear as a graded performance test. Participation in many JROTC sponsored activities requires cadets to be in uniform. As discussed in the Cadet Plan for Success, a total of 40% of the cadet's grade is based on compliance with this Uniform Policy. Cadets who fail to wear the uniform three (3) times will return it to JROTC and will be subject to reduction(s) in letter grade and cadet rank as well as involuntary removal from JROTC. In short, JROTC takes the Uniform day requirement very seriously.
